State Overview

As of October 2023, 14,008,964 individuals were enrolled in Medicaid and CHIP.¹ It is estimated that as of 2016, 318,900 people were living with HCV in California.² While Medi-Cal operates a managed care program, as of January 1, 2022, all pharmacy services transitioned from managed care to fee-for-service using a uniform preferred drug list.³

The California Medicaid Preferred Drug List includes ledipasvir/sofosbuvir and sofosbuvir/velpatasvir.4
