State Overview

As of March 2024, 699,942 individuals were enrolled in Medicaid and CHIP.¹ According to Iowa HHS, more than 18,000 Iowans have been diagnosed with chronic HCV.² As of July 1, 2022, 95% of Iowa Medicaid beneficiaries were enrolled in a managed care organization (MCO), with the remaining 5% in fee-for-service (FFS).³ Iowa Medicaid contracts with the following 3 MCOs: Iowa Total Care, Molina Healthcare of Iowa, and Wellpoint Iowa.⁴

The Iowa Medicaid Preferred Drug List designates Mayyret and sofosbuvir/velpatasvir as preferred HCV treatment regimens.⁵

Access in Managed Care		Iowa Total Care ¹¹ Molina Healthcare of Iowa, ¹² and Wellpoint Iowa ¹³ impose the same restrictions as FFS.		
Additional Restrictions	-6	Iowa Medicaid imposes additional restrictions as follows 14: • Documentation of chronic HCV diagnosis. • Documentation of genotype. • Viral load must be collected within 12 months of prior authorization request.
