
# **Hepatitis C: State of Medicaid Access Report Card**

## Kansas

#### **State Overview**

As of February 2022, 474,267 individuals were enrolled in Medicaid and CHIP.¹ It is estimated that as of 2016, 14,600 people were living with HCV in Kansas.² The Kansas Department of Health and Environment and the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services administer the Medicaid program, called KanCare. 98 percent of beneficiaries are enrolled in a managed care organization (MCO), while the remaining 2% are enrolled in fee-for-service (FFS).³ KanCare contracts with three MCOs: Aetna Better Health of Kansas, Sunflower Health Plan, and UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of Kansas.⁴

The Kansas Medicaid Preferred Drug List includes Mavyret and sofosbuvir/velpatasvir.5

Prior Authorization	-8	Prior authorization is required for all HCV treatment regimens. <sup>6</sup>		
Fibrosis Restrictions		Kansas Medicaid does not impose fibrosis restrictions. <sup>7</sup>		
Substance Use Restrictions		Kansas Medicaid does not impose substance use restrictions.8		
Prescriber Restrictions		Kansas Medicaid does not impose prescriber restrictions for initial treatment.9		
Retreatment Restrictions		Kansas Medicaid does not impose undue retreatment restrictions. 10 However, prescriptions for treatment-experienced individuals must be written by or in consultation with a specialist.		
Access in Managed Care		Aetna Better Health of Kansas, Sunflower Health Plan, and UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of Kansas impose the same requirements as FFS and use a unified prior authorization form. <sup>11</sup>		
Additional Restrictions	-4	Kansas Medicaid imposes additional restrictions as follows: <sup>12</sup> • Documentation of genotype.  • Documentation of adherence counseling.
