Grade	Recommendations to Improve Patient Access
A	Ensure transparency and parity across FFS and CCOs regarding HCV coverage criteria.

State Overview

As of September 2022, 1,347,299 individuals were enrolled in Medicaid and CHIP.¹ It is estimated that as of 2016, 48,700 people were living with HCV in Oregon.² Oregon Medicaid contracts with 12 managed care entities, referred to as coordinated care organizations (CCOs):³ Advanced Health, AllCare CCO, Cascade Health Alliance, Columbia Pacific CCO, Eastern Oregon CCO, Health Share of Oregon/CareOregon, InterCommunity Health Network CCO, Jackson Care Connect, PacificSource Community Solutions, Trillium Community Health Plan, Umpqua Health Alliance, and Yamhill Community Care.⁴

The Oregon Medicaid Preferred Drug List includes Mavyret, and sofosbuvir/velpatasvir.5

Prior Authorization		Prior authorization is not required for preferred regimens. ⁶	
Fibrosis Restrictions		Oregon Medicaid does not impose fibrosis restrictions. ⁷	
Substance Use Restrictions		Oregon Medicaid does not impose substance use restrictions.8	
Prescriber Restrictions		Oregon Medicaid does not impose prescriber restrictions.9	
Retreatment Restrictions		Oregon Medicaid does not appear to impose undue retreatment restrictions. 10	
Access in Managed Care	-8	Three CCOs impose greater restrictions than FFS, and still require prior authorization for all regimens: Advanced Health CCO, ¹¹ Cascade Health Alliance, ¹² and Eastern Oregon CCO. ¹³ Additionally, three CCOs, AllCare CCO, ¹⁴ PacificSource Community Solutions, ¹⁵ and Umpqua Healt Alliance, ¹⁶ do not require prior authorization for preferred regimens but appear to impose annua (PacificSource Community) or lifetime (AllCare, Umpqua) restrictions on treatment. Six out of twelve CCOs, Intercommunity Health Network, ¹⁷ Columbia Pacific CCO, ¹⁸ Health Share of Oregon/CareOregon, ¹⁹ Jackson Care Connect, ²⁰ Trillium Community Health Plan, ²¹ and Yamhill Community Care, ²² are in parity with FFS and do not require prior authorization for preferred regimens.	ıl
