


Hepatitis C: State of Medicaid Access Report Card

State Overview

As of August 2025, 992,278 individuals were enrolled in Medicaid and CHIP.¹ It is estimated that as of 2016, 53,300 people were living with HCV in Oklahoma.² Oklahoma Medicaid contracts with three managed care organizations (MCOs): Aetna Better Health of Oklahoma, Humana Healthy Horizons of Oklahoma, and Oklahoma Complete Health³.

The Oklahoma Medicaid Preferred Drug List designates Mavyret as the preferred agent.⁴

Deductions		Policy
Prior Authorization		Prior authorization is not required for the preferred agent (Mavyret). ⁵
Fibrosis Restrictions		Oklahoma Medicaid does not impose fibrosis restrictions. ⁶
Substance Use Restrictions		Oklahoma Medicaid does not impose substance use restrictions for the preferred agent. ⁷
Prescriber Restrictions		Oklahoma Medicaid does not impose prescriber restrictions. ⁸
Retreatment Restrictions		Oklahoma Medicaid does not impose retreatment restrictions. ⁹
Access in Managed Care		Aetna Better Health ¹⁰ , Humana Healthy Horizons ¹¹ , and Oklahoma Complete Health ¹² do not require prior authorization.
Additional Restrictions		Oklahoma Medicaid does not impose additional restrictions for the preferred agent. ¹³
